The department of Mechanical Engineering is located in Heverlee, just outside of the city center of Leuven.

We will meet in room “De Grootte-Waterkeyn”. This is at ground floor, very close to the entrance of the building indicated by the white arrow on the picture below (after entering there, just turn left). Do not take the entrance of the building close to the street (marked by the red cross on the picture below), as it is then very difficult to reach the seminar room.

How to reach the department?

From Leuven train station:

To get from Leuven train station to the Department of Mechanical Engineering in Heverlee:

- Take bus nr. 2 (direction Heverlee Campus) or 616 (direction Zaventem). You can also take bus nr. 2 in the city center, along the Bondgenotenlaan and the Naamsestraat. Get off the bus at "Campus Arenberg II" after approx. 20 (when taking bus nr. 2) or 10 (when taking bus nr. 616) minutes.
- Alternatively, you can take a taxi; this will take you less than 10'.

Coming by car:

- from Brussels, Luik (Liège/Luttich) or Aken (Aix-la-Chapelle/Aachen) via E40. Leave the E40 highway Brussels-Leuven-Luik at the exit "Leuven-E314" (A2). Leave the E314 immediately, at the exit nr. 15, "Leuven", and turn right at the third traffic lights. You are now in the Celestijnenlaan, and the Department is some 500m ahead, at your right-hand side, just across the bridge over the river Dijle.
- from Hasselt or Aken (Aix-la-Chapelle/Aachen) via E314/A2. Leave the E314/A2 highway at the exit nr. 15. The rest of the travel is explained above.

There is an open parking space in front of the building. Alternatively, you can park at parking “de Molen” on the other side of the street – see map below (for this, you need a parking code: 2000# . Do not forget to include the hashtag; you also need this code when leaving the parking lot).

Coming from Brussels airport (Zaventem):

- By train: Entering the arrival hall, go to your right. You will find escalators and elevators going to LEVEL -1. Level -1 is the train station of the airport. There are two trains an hour leaving from the airport to Leuven (NOT Louvain(-La-Neuve!)). Leuven is the first stop after about 15 minutes. See <http://www.belgianrail.be/en/>
- By taxi: A taxi takes about 25 minutes from Brussels Airport to Leuven (there can be traffic jams though, dependent on hour of the day). A single journey will cost about 70 euro. Always take a taxi at the official taxi stand.

The Department of Mechanical Engineering is easily recognizable by the big winch in front of it.
